Amidst some challenges faced by church leaderships in the UK and Ireland, an initiative is underway to foster greater unity. Our sister church in London has reached out to a group who have helped with similar issues in India - Douglas Arthur, Ed Anton, Valdur Koha, and Walter Evans.

The idea of involving other churches in the UK and Ireland led to a meeting on July 30th. Attendees included members from various leadership teams across the UK and Ireland, including our own Watford team. Now, the question is before us - should we engage in this unity process? A decision has been requested by the end of August.

As a leadership team, we're committed to prayer and engaging all of us in this church. Therefore we wanted to bring this to your attention, and ask for your input. I am sure you have questions, so please speak to me, Penny, the Makinsons or the Oliviers — our leadership team.

In response to the situation I will be sharing some lessons from Scripture on what Biblical unity is — what Jesus prayed for in John 17.
