### Rahab's New Thing

We are looking at God doing a new thing in Rahab's life. She is a fascinating character

- She does almost all the talking.
- She is shown as, in some ways, out-smarting the spies and the King.
- She is outside the people of God yet has inside knowledge of God's plans
- She is on the edge of town (inside the city wall) and closer to the purposes of God.
- She has a questionable trade going on under her roof, but is open to the moving of God in her life.
- She has control over the spies' lives and yet recognises that they have power over her destiny.
- She saves the spies, but is saved by them.
- She is in Jesus's genealogy (Matthew 1:5)
- She is an inspiration of faith (Hebrews 11:31)
- She is considered righteous (James 2:25

"Before the spies lay down for the night, she went up on the roof and said to them, "I know that the LORD has given you this land and that a great fear of you has fallen on us, so that all who live in this country are melting in fear because of you. We have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red Sea for you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to Sihon and Og, the two kings of the Amorites east of the Jordan, whom you completely destroyed. When we heard of it, our hearts melted in fear and everyone's courage failed because of you, for the LORD your God is God in heaven above and on the earth below." (Joshua 2:8-11)



Rahab knows that God is at work. Many have heard of what God is doing (parting the Red Sea). Many have experienced what God is doing (the destruction of Sihon & Og). Many are worried about what is going to happen (hearts melted in fear). But only Rahab 'knows' what God is doing ("I know that...")

Rahab 'knows' God is doing a new thing ("...the LORD has given you this land...")

#### For Reflection

It is one thing to hear about God, but an entirely different thing to recognising the relevance for our own lives. Have you heard about God moving in someone else's life, or in a different church?

Could this be a faith-inspiration for you? What is the relevance of other people's good news for you?
