Fruitful? Or Successful?

Here's a question for you. What's the difference between being fruitful and successful?

God frequently commanded fruitfulness:

"God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the earth."" (Genesis 1:22 NIV11) (see also Gen. 1:28; 8:17; 9:1, 7; 35:11; Jer. 23:3; Ezek. 36:11)

Also, consider this. Bearing fruit is a sign of discipleship:

""I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing... This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." (John 15:5, 8 NIV11)

We are *meant* to be fruitful. We are *designed* for it. But we are not commanded to be successful. What is the difference? In fact, *is* there a difference? I think so because success seems to be a human-focused approach, whereas fruitfulness implies God's intervention. But what do you think?
