Give me oil in my lamp!

Our third song this Sunday is the chorus, "Give me oil in my lamp". Sometimes the simplest songs, like this one, may be underestimated in their spiritual significance. With that in mind, let me share some thoughts. You could use these for personal devotions this week.

Have you ever run out of oil? Back in the 90s, I had a car with a leaky engine cylinder. It used a whole container of oil on the drive to Birmingham and back. The amount of smoke behind me would, these days, get me pulled over. I liked to think of it as the pillar of cloud leading others to the promised land! However, the oil in this song bears a different message.

1. "Give me oil in my lamp, keep me burning"

The wise virgins kept their lamps burning with oil, being ready for the bridegroom.

Luke 12:35 – "Be dressed ready for service and keep your lamps burning." (also Matthew 25:1-4)

Question: What helps you to be spiritually prepared, keeping your faith alive and active?

2. "Give me oil in my lamp, I pray"

Ephesians 5:18 – "Be filled with the Spirit." Romans 13:11 – "The hour has come for you to wake from sleep."

Question: How does prayer help you to keep your spiritual fervour (Rom. 12.11)?

3. "Keep me burning till the break of day"

Galatians 6:9 – "Let us not become weary in doing good... we will reap a harvest if we do not give up." 2 Timothy 4:7 – "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith."

Question: What keeps you going when you are tired?

4. "Sing hosanna, sing hosanna, sing hosanna to the King of Kings"

Psalm 95:1-2 – "Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation." Revelation 5:13 – "Every creature in heaven, on earth, and under the earth sings praise to Christ."

Question: What part does worship play in fuelling your spiritual lamp?

5. "Give me joy in my heart, keep me singing"

Philippians 4:4 – "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!" Psalm 28:7 – "The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy..."

Question: What helps refresh your gratitude and revitalise your joy when it wanes?

6. "Give me peace in my heart, keep me resting"

John 14:27 – "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you." Philippians 4:6-7 – "Do not be anxious... and the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."

Question: What channels do you access to help you experience the peace of Christ?

Why not take some time this week to explore how to be filled and refilled with a spirit of perseverance, joy and peace? In that way, we will worship well and experience the rest that Christ offers.
